Year 5 – Invitation to join Free Bicycle Training, Summer 2025

Your child is invited to apply for free bicycle training which is provided by qualified instructors from the Royal Borough of Kingston (RBK). *The courses take place during school hours in April and May.*

In these enjoyable sessions, children learn basic Highway Code, develop their skills in school/on the road, and can attain two standards (BikeAbility Level 1 or 2). Certificates and badges will also be awarded.

Proposed event	When	Either w/c 28 th April or w/c 5 th May
	What	Each child receives 6 hours of bicycle training (2 hours in the playground and 2 x 2 hours on the road). All training is outdoor based.
		Teachers schedule the training so that there is minimal disruption to school work.
	Cost	There is no cost. However, if your child does not attend their booked course, the school may be charged a $\pounds40$ cancellation fee.
Additional information	In order for children to take part they will need to a) have a correctly sized and roadworthy bicycle and	
	b) have reasonable control of a bicycle . This must include starting/stopping quickly, swerving to avoid objects and looking around – including behind.	
	c) bring their own helmet and hi-viz tabard (or wear a bright t-shirt or jacket). The school can provide a hi-viz tabard if required.	
	U	Infortunately, this training is not suitable for complete beginners.
